

## **Adobe Illustrator Intermediate Creating Digital Artwork and Type**

The emphasis of this Intermediate course is on accurate transformations of objects; creating, controlling and manipulating type; and on using layers and appearance attributes. The subject matter will be covered in a series of short, self-contained projects.

### **Accurate Transformations**

multiple transformations • controlling position, scale, rotation, distortion, shear and reflection  
free transformation

### **Working With Type And Images**

document properties • linked and embedded images • type: character attributes (font, size, style, colour) • leading, kerning and tracking • vertical type • type on a path • warping text • placing text from a file • multi-column text • paragraph attributes • wrapping text around an object • type outlines • type masks

### **Layers**

creating, viewing and locking layers • moving objects between layers • merging layers

### **Appearance Attributes**

using appearance attributes • live effects • creating and using graphic styles
