By the end of the course you will be able to set up a new site, arrange text and images on it, make navigation links between the pages of the site, use templates and external style sheets to ensure a consistent look to the site, and upload it to a web host.

In addition to the use of Dreamweaver, the course covers basic HTML and CSS but not JavaScript, except for the functions provided automatically by Dreamweaver.
